

# CPA REQUIREMENTS

The **California State Board of Accountancy** determines what courses will accept to meet the requirements for **CPA License**. That is why it is important that you review all of the requirements on their website before enrolling in courses.

As of January 1, 2014, there have been changes to the CPA requirements. You should contact The CA State Board of Accountancy if you have questions about what courses to take.

If you are considering applying to become a CPA, you will eventually be sending your transcripts to the CA State Board of Accountancy for evaluation. Therefore please be sure to review their website and understand the **New Licensure Requirements**. This is a link on the CBA homepage and has several resources with detailed information about CPA requirements, including educational requirements.
